New into Peacock Manor- Seated Boxing

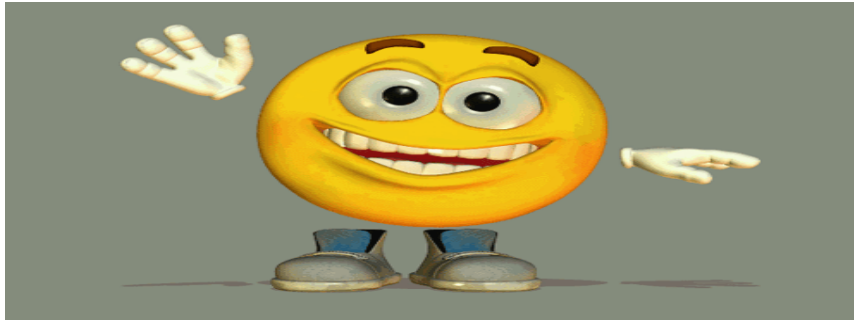
We had our residents try Seated Boxing, absolutely loved it. Sally went around and we had good practice session. We are going to try to incorporate into a bit of a fun session on a morning.
